Insurance FAQ's

Your health insurance policy is an agreement between *you and your insurance company*. It is generally negotiated by your employer if it is an employee benefit. Federal law now mandates that everyone is required to obtain health insurance through their employer or on the open market. Current health insurance policies require patients to satisfy a deductible, co-payment and / or co-insurance requirements for their insurance that makes it difficult for providers to obtain payment in a reasonable amount of time. There is NO REQUIREMENT that your healthcare provider submit an invoice your insurance company for services that he/she provides to you.

RESULTS PT does NOT participate with any health insurance plans. Results PT will provide you with an invoice for the services provided to you. You may submit your invoice to your insurance company for payment of your physical therapy services. As all insurance plans are different, you must check with your insurance provider or written policy to understand what your insurance will cover for physical therapy benefits.
